### BANBURY COMMUNITY PAVILLION

**Client:** Banbury Town Council

**Location:** Banbury

**Duration:** February 2020 to August 2020

**Project Value:** £200,000

### SCOPE

Hackwood Homes was appointed on behalf of Banbury Town Council to construct the new Community Pavillion for the Peoples Park in Banbury.



**The works included, but were not limited to;**

The brief received from Banbury Town Council was 'to construct a new modular structure to provide a pavilion building which should contain the following elements. The bulk of the building was manufactured off site at Hackwood's headquarters before being transported to site and assembled;

- A staff mess room to be used by staff in the park for breaks and lunches. The room contains a food preparation space/team point;
- External toilets for the public including baby changing facilities and disabled provision;
- A covered outdoor area for demonstrations and workshops.'

One of the key factors in the project was to provide an environmentally sustainable building with minimal carbon footprint, something we have prided ourselves on for all of our projects, through utilization of timber and by using sustainable materials.

The specific scope of works were as follows;

- Site set-up;
- Preparation of ground works and services;
- Installation of the new building;
- Associated landscaping.
